CUT THE DIAMOND
BOX THE TOP
CLOVER AND (ANYTHING)
TRANSFER THE COLUMN:

(currently in the A1 Program)
Starting Formation: Columns
Action: #1 and #2 dancers in each Column Circulate 3 spots (working slightly wider than usual, to give the centres room) and Face In. Meanwhile the #3 and #4 dancers Circulate One Position, then Cast off 3/4 and Extend.
Ending Formation: Parallel waves.
Timing: 8 beats

SNEAK PREVIEW OF THE MEETING

What is wrong with the following choreography?

Patter:

HEADS SQUARE THRU FOUR, STAR THRU, PASS THRU, WHEEL AND DEAL, CENTRES PASS THRU, SWING THRU, GIRLS CIRCULATE, SWING THRU, FAN THE TOP, SINGLE HINGE, GIRLS RUN, GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT

SIDES FLUTTERWHEEL AND SWEEP 1/4, PASS THRU, TOUCH 1/4, SPLIT CIRCULATE, SINGLE HINGE, RECYCLE, VEER LEFT, WHEEL AND DEAL, LEFT ALLEMANDE

HEADS STAR THRU AND CALIFORNIA TWIRL, DIVE THRU, CENTRE LADIES CHAIN, CENTRES PASS THRU, TOUCH 1/4, CENTRES TRADE, SWING THRU, MEN RUN, BEND THE LINE, RIGHT AND LEFT THRU, LADIES CHAIN INTO A PROMENADE

What is wrong continued

Singing Call figures:
(both are recent record releases)

HEADS STAR THRU and CALIFORNIA TWIRL, DOSADO, SWING THRU, GIRLS CIRCULATE, BOYS TRADE, BOYS RUN, BEND THE LINE, GO UP AND BACK, SLIDE THRU, SQUARE THRU 3, SWING, PROMENADE

HEADS PASS THE OCEAN, SWING THRU, BOYS RUN, VEER RIGHT, SWING THRU, SINGLE HINGE, BOYS RUN, REVERSE FLUTTERWHEEL and SWEEP 1/4, VEER RIGHT, PROMENADE

Hash Cues:
TWO FORWARD TWO-STEPS,
FACE AND HALF A BOX,
SCISSORS THRU TO SEMI,
WALK TWO, TWO TURNING TWO-STEPS
FACE TO FACE and BACK TO BACK
WALK and PICKUP,
DOUBLE PROGRESSIVE SCISSORS
VINE FOUR, TWIRL TWO,
APART AND POINT

CHOREOGRAPHY PUZZLE:

Resolve the square in 5 moves or less using Mainstream moves.

HEADS PASS THE OCEAN, EXTEND, GIRLS CROSS RUN, LEFT SWING THRU, CAST OFF LEFT 3/4, CENTRES HINGE, VERY CENTRES TRADE,
